READY4Disasters Partners Meet Face to Face in Greece

1st Kickoff Meeting

The kick-off meeting was organized by the host partner OIKO.POLI.S in Greece. During the two days, the participants discussed the project objectives and concretized tasks and activities. Important decisions were taken concerning the future activities to be implemented during the project development. Administrative and dissemination issues were also discussed.

The main objectives of the kickoff meeting were:

- ✓ To share information about partner institutions among the project group
- ✓ To share motivations and wishes for outcomes
- ✓ Better understanding and discussion of the project objectives

The first day of the meeting started with a game of acquaintance. The partners presented brief information about their expertise as an institute/organization, the strengths of their institutions and their contribution to the project.

They visit the Diomideios Botanical Garden and watched presentations on "Fire Protection at the Botanical Garden", about floods and industrial disasters and the Municipality's of Chaidari the Business Plan for natural disaster.

The second day the project team attended a visit to 1st Department of National Disasters, Elefsina and they watched presentations about civil protection plan, previous disasters, and future planning. Additionally, the project partners had the opportunity to see the rescue equipment.
