Training Material Development: Collaborative brainstorming and development of innovative educational materials by participating organizations.

OER Platform Completion: The Open Educational Resources (OER) platform is now complete, facilitating pilot tests and the finalization of the Methodology and Toolkit Manual.

Training Materials Prepared: All training materials are available in five languages, designed based on a competence map from surveys with experienced volunteers.

Interactive Mobile App and Game Update: The final version of the interactive mobile app and game is released, serving as a digital trainer to enhance practical prevention and preparedness skills for volunteers and trainers.

3rd International Meeting: Held in Georgia from June 26-28, 2024, this meeting significantly advanced the project's objectives.

Upcoming Webinars: Two webinars scheduled for October and November 5, 2024, open to all participants.

Closing Conference: Planned for November 2024 at Gebze Technical University, this comprehensive conference will feature international participation and showcase the project's outcomes.



An Overview of Open Educational Resources

Completion of Online Education Platform and OERs

• **Final Development Stage**: We have successfully reached the concluding phase in the development of the Open Educational Resources (OER) platform.

• **Translation and Adaptation**: The educational modules and OERs have been translated and adapted into the national languages of the partner institutions (Turkish, Italian, Georgian and Greek).

• **Pilot Testing Methodology Established**: The methodology for pilot testing the OER platform, covering 8 modules and 48 units, has been determined. This will involve testing the platform and all modules with a selected group of users to identify potential issues and collect feedback for further enhancements.

An interactive wheel * was created that enables learners, depending on the knowledge they want to acquire, to follow one of the 9 educational pathways.

• Handbook Methodology and Toolkit Updates:


The final Handbook Methodology and Toolkit are ready. They aim to describe a common methodology to evaluate the Ready4Disasters training

We're excited to share updates on the mobile game designed to enhance disaster management training. The development process has been progressing smoothly with significant milestones achieved recently.


• Android Version Nearly Complete: The Android version of our interactive game is nearly ready for launch. • **iOS Version in Progress**: Development for the iOS version is well underway. This expansion is part of our commitment to making the educational tool accessible to a broader audience. The iOS version is expected to mirror the Android version in functionality and educational content, ensuring that all users have a consistent and informative experience regardless of their device type.

Both versions of the game aim to provide a comprehensive educational experience, enhanced by real-life scenarios that teach users how to effectively manage disasters. The game also includes a manual to guide users on how to maximize their learning outcomes, making it a valuable resource for disaster management training.

The READY4Disaster project partners met in Tbilisi, Georgia attending the 3rd international project meeting!



Also, a mini-workshop was held to finalize and perfect the game scenarios. Project participants visited the Museum of Firefighters in Tbilisi and also, had an interesting Technical Visit to the training center of the emergency management service, where they viewed the simulation environment of various rescue operations.
