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# READY4DISaster training modules (Result 2)

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The second project result is the creation and implementation of training modules for civil protection volunteers.

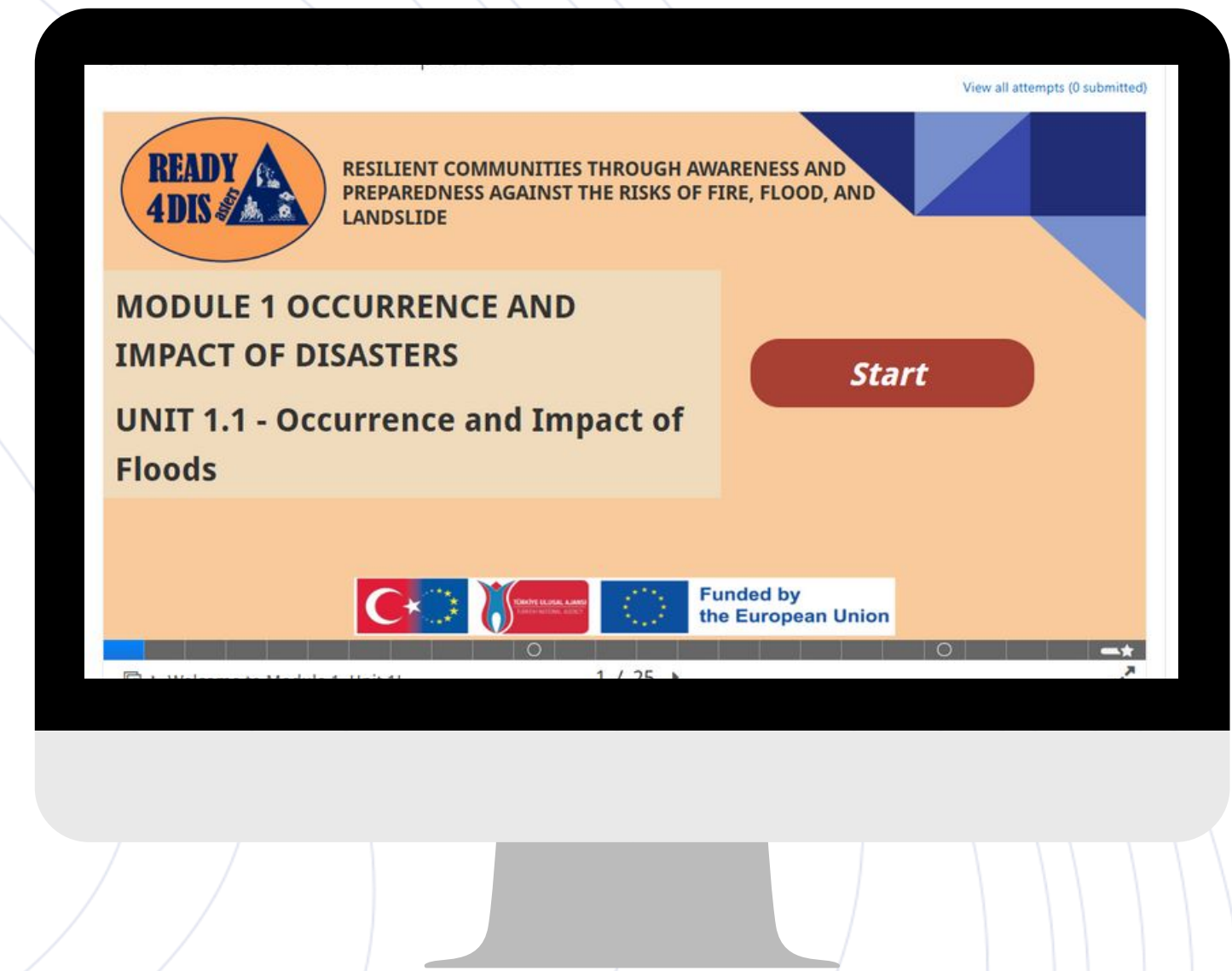
- The modules are developed under the form of **Open Education Resources (OER)**.
- These modules are hosted on a dedicated **e-learning platform** and can be **accessed via the project website**.
- The modules are available in **English, Turkish, Italian, Greek and Georgian** on the project website.



# The READY4Disaster training modules and OER

The READY4Disaster 8 training modules are divided into several learning units.

1. Occurrences and impact of disasters
2. Flood disasters
3. Landslide disasters
4. Fire-related disasters
5. Rescue and rescue equipment (for floods, fires, landslides)
6. Promoting prevention over recovery
7. Resiliency metrics/indicator
8. The EU civil protection mechanism



# READY4Disaster training modules structure

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The READY4DISASTER training modules and OERs offers an interactive and engaging learning experience.

Each of the 8 modules and related units includes:

1. **Interactive presentations** with quizzes, images, videos and external links.
2. **Self-assessment test** to reinforce learning and acknowledge acquired learning.
3. In-depth **document** ( Chapters) that offers a **detailed exploration of the module's topics**, allowing learners to delve deeper into the subject matter.

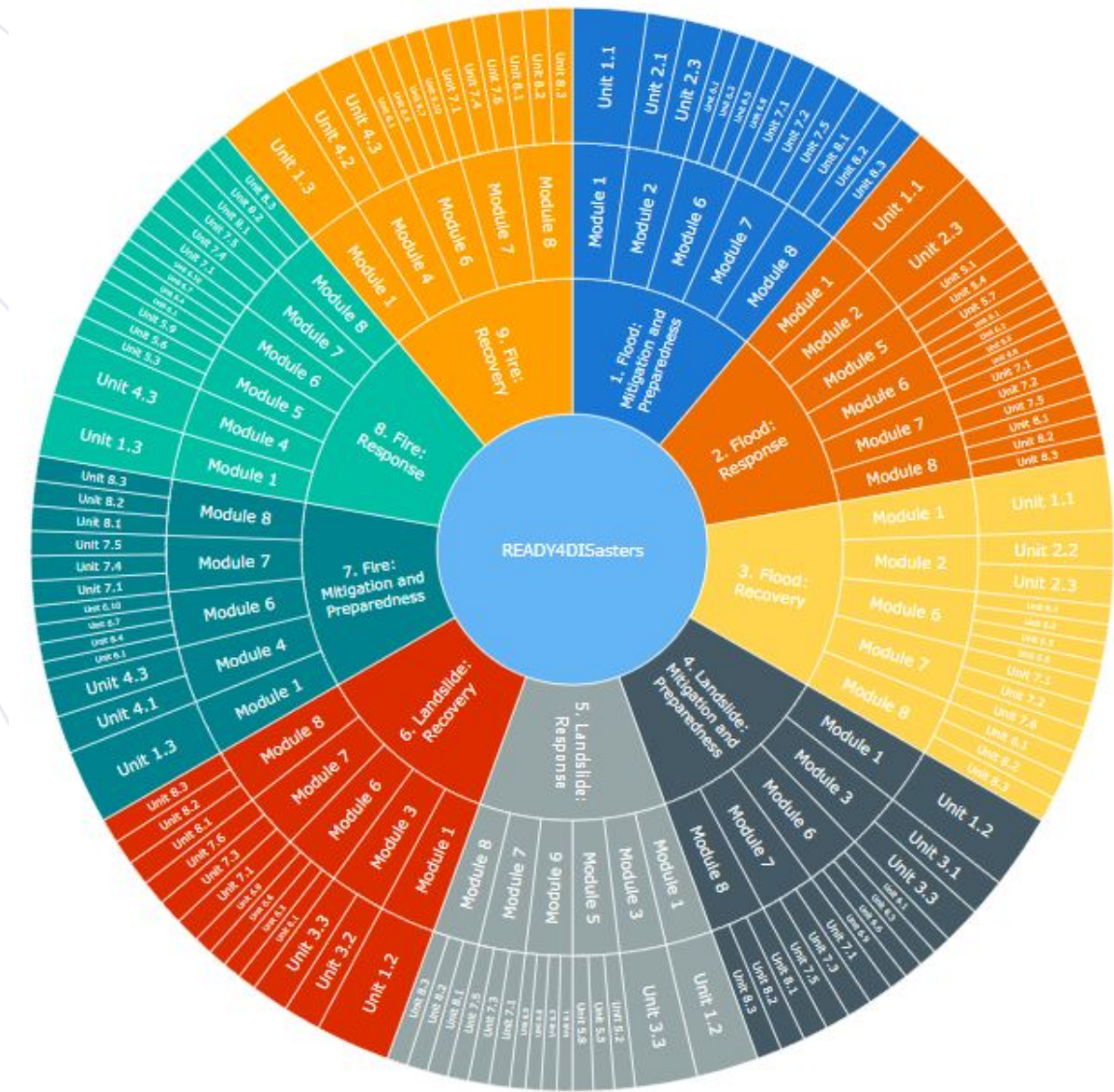
# How to access the training modules?

Learners can access the OERs via the project website, no registration is required.

1. Via an interactive wheel: For each of the 3 natural disasters (Flood, landslide, and fire) learners can choose to start their learning path in:

- mitigation and preparedness
- response
- recovery

2. Via a simple table with links.

The OER offers valuable insights from real-world disasters, such as:

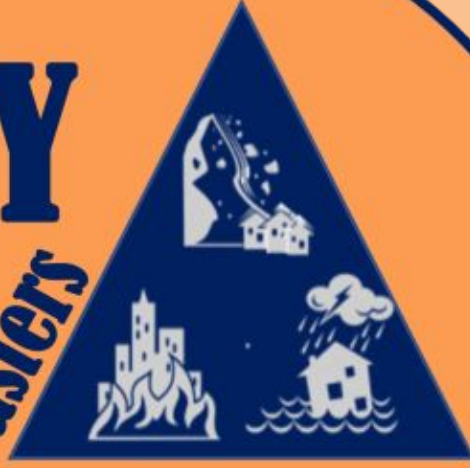
- Floods in the Emilia-Romagna region (Italy) in May 2023
